Population

- Total population (000)
- Annual growth rate (%)
- Dependency ratio (per r1000)
- Percentage of population aged 60+ years
- Total fertility rate

Probability of Dying (per 1000)

- Under age 5 (m/f)
- Between ages 15 and 59 years (m/f)

Life expectancy at Birth (years m/f)

**Deaths by Cause, Sex, and Mortality Stratum in WHO Region**

Cause (total deaths, and % total)

- + burden of disease in disability-adjusted life-years (DALYS
